#### 1. Report on the Financial Statements

#### CORPORATE INFORMATION

#### G Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents for the purposes of cash flow statement comprise cash at bank and in hand and short-term investments with an original maturity of three months or less.

Deferred Tax resulting from "timing difference" between book and taxable profit is accounted for using the tax rates and laws that are enacted or substantively enacted as on the balance sheet date. The deferred tax asset is recognised and carried forward only to the extent that there is a reasonable certainty that sufficient future taxable income will be available against which such deferred tax asset can be realized.

#### I Investments

All other investments are classified as Long Term Investments. On initial recognition, all investments are measured at cost.
